### Car Riders

All students will be dismissed at 2:45 p.m. The student pick-up and drop-off drive-through is located on the South side of the building.

### Bus Pick-up/Drop-off

Students will enter and exit from buses on the North side of the building. Parents will not be allowed to pick-up or drop-off their children in this area.

### Walkers/Bikers

Students who will be walking or riding their bikes to school must stay on the sidewalk and cross in the designated crosswalks. As students approach the school, they will enter the building in either the front door on the West side of the building or the back door on the East side of the building.
